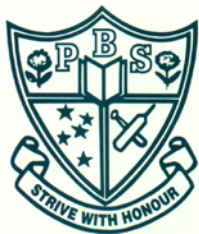

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Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Special Religious Education (SRE) is an integral part of the curriculum in government schools. Representatives of approved religious persuasions have an opportunity to provide SRE in every government school in NSW.

The content of SRE classes is specific to each religion or denomination. It is not the same as General Religious Education which is a component mainly of the Human Society and Its Environment key learning area. General Religious Education involves learning about religions, the place of religion in society and the importance of religious beliefs for particular individuals and communities.

The religious persuasions providing SRE at our school and the contact persons are set out on the reverse side of this letter.

When you enrol a child you may, if you wish, nominate a SRE class for your child to attend. Your child will then automatically be placed in the relevant SRE class. But you have the right then, or at any other time, to ask that your child be transferred to a different SRE class or to be withdrawn from SRE. Alternatively, the school will be guided by information on the enrolment form.

The teachers who provide SRE have to be authorised by their religious persuasion and many of them have completed special training. They use material provided by their religious persuasion.

Because the teachers and the materials they use are authorised by the religious persuasions, not by the school, any concerns or questions about the content of the SRE classes should be referred to the relevant contact person for your children scripture group. If your question or concern is not addressed through the process please raise the matter with the school.

Religion is an important element in the development of cultures and plays a significant role in the community. I trust that your child will benefit from the religious education opportunities provided.

Ethics classes are always in high demand, with limited teachers, so a policy of priority to students who bring their notes in first applies. If your child misses out they will attend non-scripture and go on a waiting list should positions become available.

We appreciate your support in this matter.

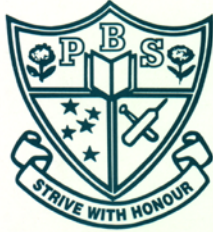

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Dear Parents/Carers,

Schools request a contribution from parents each year to supplement existing funding. Schools rely on these contributions to provide additional resources and learning programs for our students. How To Install Skoolbag On Your Smartphone

For iPhone and iPad users:

1. Click the "App Store" icon on your Apple device.
2. Type your school name in the search, using suburb name will help.
3. You will see your school appear, click "Get" then "install".
4. The app is FREE to download.
5. When installed click "Open"
6. Select "OK" to receive push notifications, when asked.
7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.



For Android users:

You must first have signed up with a Google Account before installing the app.

1. Click the "Play Store" button on your Android Device
2. Click the magnifying glass icon at the top and type in your school name, using suburb name will help.
3. Click the school name when it appears in the search.
4. Click the "Install" button.
5. Click "Accept" for various permissions (please note, we do not modify any of your personal data on your device).
6. Click "Open" when installed.
7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.



Please Note: Some brands of Android phones need the setting in "Notification Manager" changed to "Allow" instead of "Notify" in order for the push notifications to work. The phone must also be running at least version 4 system software to run the app.

For Windows 8.1 Phone and Windows 8.1 or 10 device users:

1. Go to the Windows Store on your 8.1 Windows Phone or Windows 8.1/10 Device
2. Search for "Skoolbag" in the keyword app search
3. Install the Skoolbag app
4. Find your school either by using the keyword search or location service.
5. Click the "Pin" icon to pin the school tile to your Windows Phone home screen.
6. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup"
7. Toggle the Push Categories that are applicable to you by tapping the on/off switch.

Please Note: The Skoolbag Windows App is for 8.1 version Windows Phones, or Windows 8.1 and 10 devices.
