## Third-party software consent

Dear Parents/carers

Blackheath School is committed to providing a technology-rich environment for our students. Our school community considers the use of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) to be fundamental in assisting teaching and learning in all areas of the school curriculum.

The school uses third-party providers offering web-based educational resources and cloud-based storage to support our administrative functions and enhance student learning outcomes. The department has a service agreement with some providers it has assessed as meeting privacy and security standards required of the department.

The school offers students access to several services in addition to these. In most instances, students are required to register before accessing an online service. Registration involves either a staff member or student entering identifying information such as name, grade, and email address onto the provider's platform. This and any other data entered in the course of accessing the application may be stored on servers located in Australia or offshore in a country not subject to NSW privacy laws.

Your consent is required for your child's information to be provided to these thirdparty providers. Before giving your consent, it is important you understand what student information is collected, how it will be used and who may have access to it.

The table on the next page lists each of the third-party providers the school intends to use with a link to the website. Please note that not all students, in all grades or classes will be utilising these sites and applications. However, they may at some stage in their time at Blackheath Public School access these learning sites and applications.

Please return the permission slip on page 3 by Monday 20 March to ensure we can continue to utilise these apps or look at alternatives if permission is not granted.
