Over 23,000 students along with their teachers/principals attend this event around Australia annually. Transport for the excursion will be by train and light rail, so a child Opal card will be required with required funds for return travel from Katoomba Train Station to Central Train Station and the light rail from Central Station to the ICC Sydney Convention Centre.

The cost of entry and participation in workshops has been funded by the school.
