

**Narragunnawali Music Festival (4/06/2025 to 24/09/2025)**

Your child has expressed interest in singing in the Blackheath Public Year 2 choir at the 'Narragunnawali' Festival of music. The festival choir will be made up of students from 5 other local Public Schools. The festival is held annually at Katoomba High school, with the first two rehearsals held at Katoomba North Public School, and the final rehearsal held at Katoomba High School. The rehearsal and performance dates are:

Rehearsal 1, Katoomba North PS: Week 6 Term 2, Wednesday 4th June, 9:30am - 12:30pm (BUS)

Rehearsal 2, Katoomba North PS: Week 6 Term 3 Wednesday 27th August, 9:30am – 12:30pm (BUS)

Rehearsal 3, Katoomba High School: Week 10 Term 3, Monday 22nd September, 9:30 - 12:30pm (BUS)

Evening Performance 1: KHS: Week 10 Term 3, Monday 22nd September, 6.30pm – 7.30pm (Parents to transport)

Evening Performance 2: KHS: Week 10 Term 3, Wednesday 24th September, 6.30-7.30pm. (Parents to transport)

Students will need to bring their lyrics, wear their school uniform and bring their recess food to each of the three rehearsals. Students are to meet Mrs Lanyon at the school canteen by 8:50am on the morning of each rehearsal. We will return to school in time for lunch.

The participation cost for each child, including bus transport to the rehearsals, is \$15.00. This payment is due by Wednesday June 4th.

Students will continue to learn the songs for the concert during their class music lessons. Parents are asked to assist their child by downloading the teaching tracks so that students can also practise at home. The link to the teaching tracks is:
